### **2007 Playoff Notebook:**

- Career is the defending SCC champion... The Panthers defeated Hillhouse, 64-51, in the 2006 final.
- Guilford is making its 13<sup>th</sup> straight appearance in the playoffs – the only SCC school to make all 13. The Indians have won four titles (1997, 2001, 2002 and 2003) tied with Hillhouse for the most in league history.
- Mercy is making its 11<sup>th</sup> playoff appearance.
- Hand is the number-one seed for the first time. The Tigers are making their eighth playoff appearance.
- Cheshire is making its eighth playoff appearance.
- East Haven is making its third playoff appearance and first since 2003.
- Hamden is making its sixth appearance and first since 2004.
- Jonathan Law is making its first SCC playoff appearance.
